

#### Monday- Mark 1:29-39 – Lectio Divina

Read the Passage, reflect on: What word or phrase jumped out to you? Read Passage, reflect on: How do you spend time with God? Read Passage, relect on: What is God calling you to do through this passage?

#### **Thursday- Walking Prayer**

Take a walk (inside or out), at different points along the walk stop and read a psalm from Psalm 120 through Psalm 134. These are the psalm of ascent. Jews sang them as they journeyed to the Temple in Jerusalem.

#### Friday- The Daily Office

Go to this website: https://www.dailyoffice2019.com/. Read and Pray at least the Morning, Midday, Evening, or Compline (Bedtime) prayer.

#### Tuesday- Breath Prayer

Find a quiet place and relax. Set a timer for 15 minutes. Close your eyes. Everytime you breath in and out in your mind say a number 1,2,3... when you get to 10 start over. When you have a random thought come in just focus again on counting your breath.

#### Wednesday- Jesus Prayer

Find a quiet place and relax. Set a timer for 15 minutes. Close your eyes. You slowly repeat the phrase "Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us a sinner"

#### Saturday- Five Finger Prayer

Thumb- Pray for those closest to you, Index- church leaders/teachers (those who have guided you, Middle-National/State/Local leaders. Ring- those who are in need. Pinky- Pray for yourself.

Notes:
